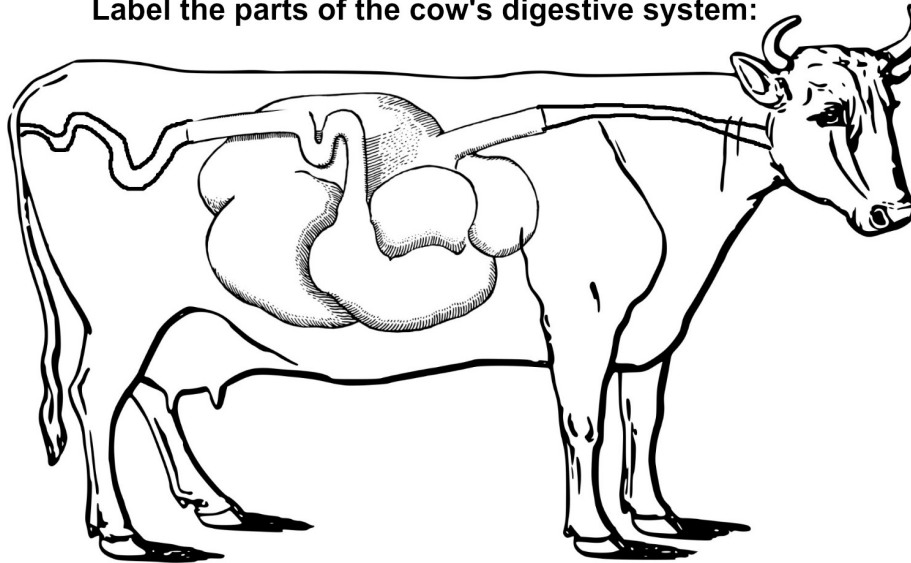


Write the number that corresponds to each stage of the cow's digestive process in the order it occurs.
The first one is done for you.

- 1 The cow eats grass.
- The abomasum removes additional nutrients from the cud.
- The cud is passed back to the cow's mouth.
- The grass is broken down into small pieces (cud) by the reticulum.
- The grass is stored in the rumen and digestion is started.
- The cud is passed into the intestines.
- The cud is passed into the omasum for nutrient absorption.
- The remaining cud is processed by the intestines and turned into cow manure.
